Our first strategic plan

paved the way for our building which opened in 2000. Our last plan identified the need to open our doors wider in order to serve all levels of developmental disabilities. And out of that plan came the goal to literally open our doors wider to include all who are able to benefit from our programs – regardless of their ability level.

We have embraced a concept called Universal Design (UD), in which buildings and objects are designed so that everyone can enjoy and use them in the same way, regardless of ability. To that end, we've been involved in a capital campaign to retrofit our building to the principles of Universal Design. When we reach our \$5 million campaign goal — our building, as beautiful as it is, will be transformed into a seamless environment that supports all abilities equally through Universal Design.

As I learn about and speak to people on this design principle I have come to believe that UD is more than a building or an environment — it's about an attitude. We believe that people with developmental disabilities should be part of the community, experience continued growth and enjoy a good quality of life. We are not able to achieve this vision on our own — we need your help.

Whether it's by making a donation to CEL; making sure that businesses and communities are welcoming and supportive to people with disabilities; and/or providing much needed employment to the most underemployed demographic in Illinois and across the nation — if we each play a role, the transformation to full equality will take place that much sooner.



2012 Accomplishments

The Center Presents (TCP) was created in response to member requests for weekday afternoon programs for teens and adults, reflecting the budgets, varied interests and schedules of our members. After-school satellites offered programming in a youth's own school in response to parents' desire that there not be long travel times at the end of the day.

Our REACH Day Program experienced a 34% increase in membership in FYI2 and continues to grow. It currently serves an average of 19 people per day, with new members joining every month. This program fills a critical void for young adults age 22 transitioning out of school, as well as older adults looking for an alternative to the workshop environment. The REACH employment readiness component offers job skill experience to the members.

Josh, Jay, Matt, Collette and Becky joined the Membership Advisory Council (MAC), created in FY 2012 to act as liaisons between the general membership and staff. Together they practice leadership and self-advocacy skills.

As we open our doors to members with a wider range of developmental disabilities, we're enhancing staff training, including training on autism. In FY12, all program staff became certified in Quality Behavioral Services (QBS, Inc.) Safety-Care program, learning how to de-escalate behavioral crises and physically intervene in an emergency. We continued to offer comprehensive training to all staff, including CPR, First Aid, and how to identify and report abuse and neglect.

CEL initiated a Quality Assurance program, which will systematically examine each program we run for effectiveness and ways to improve. Evaluation criteria include opportunities for members to problem-solve and self-advocate; use of volunteers; and member to staff ratios.

The Healthy Lifestyles agencywide initiative, which raises
members' awareness of good
nutrition and fitness, continues to
make an impact. In 2012, REACH
began Club Fit, a more intensive
weekly class focused on movement
and exercise. Members walk with
pedometers, lift weights, practice
yoga, and do balance exercises.

Programs

School-age Youth

Youth programs serve people ages 13 to 22, through after-school programs, excursions and summer camp.






Students in an After School Satellite Social Club find passing a marble through cardboard tubes is a fun challenge that develops team work, concentration and coordination.





CEL Develops Social Skills

For someone with autism, it is often extremely difficult to make eye contact. The slightest noise can be extremely painful and uncomfortable. The human touch is not always appreciated. Communicating and connecting socially to others does not come easily.

When Billy first came to CEL after transitioning out of high school, he made it clear that he was not comfortable here. He needed headphones to help minimize ambient noise, and wears them less often now.





Today after nearly 3 years in the REACH program, Billy is able to look you in the eye. He enjoys acting on stage and has had lead roles in our Sunday Drama Club productions.


